



Health Safety and Environmental (HSE) Management Systems Policy

ORGANISATION

The CFB Health Safety and Environmental (HSE) management systems are detailed in the CFB HSE Manuals.

The CFB HSE committee will be composed of

- Chief Fire Officer (CFO)
- Deputy Chief Fire Officer (DCFO)
- Senior Management
- Safety Coordinator
- Staff Representatives

CFB HSE Organisation Charts are detailed in the CFB HSE Manuals.

ARRANGEMENTS

Objectives and Targets

Safety, environmental protection and fire safety are line management responsibilities. The CFO delegates the task of discharging these responsibilities and applying the policy throughout all levels of line management within the organisation. In order to meet these objectives the CFO or the DCFO will chair the HSE committee meetings, which will be held regularly and will have representation across the organisation. CFB performance indicators will be measured, managed, monitored and reviewed through the station committee structure.

The HSE committee will maintain close liaison with regulatory bodies and HSE initiatives will be promulgated throughout the station by the same.

This statement will be communicated to all CFB employees and members of the public where required.

Training

HSE training will be provided in accordance with training needs analyses (TNA) and health, safety and fire legislation. Line management will monitor the effectiveness of the TNA.

Contractors

Where this policy statement does not satisfy the requirements of contractors, sub-contractors, private companies etc, the extent of the my HSE responsibilities toward them is as follows:-

Heads of these organisations should produce their own Policy statements and other safety documentation to ensure it mutually embraces, cooperates and coordinates with the CFB HSE management systems. Any such organisations will be were applicable, represented to the HSE Committee meetings.

Review

This statement will be reviewed to reflect the changes in legislation, Governmental policy and HSE Management Systems at CFB Gibraltar.

Performance of the HSE management systems at CFB Gibraltar will be measured by internal inspections and audits undertaken on a continuous programme throughout the CFB by the HSE committee.
