IMPORTANT BBQ INFORMATION

1- Public and Communal Areas

- You must seek permission from the Landlord / Management Company to organise a BBQ in any area that does not belong to you.

2- Beach BBQs

- **PERMIT ONLY!** This can be obtained from the 'Department of the Environment, Heritage and Climate Change, Upper Rock and Beaches'.

3-BBQs on Upper Rock

- BBQs are NOT allowed within the Upper Rock Nature Reserve, with the following exceptions:
 - 1- G.L.O- Gibraltar Scouts Association
 - 2- Girl Guides
 - 3- Residents within their respective properties.

For each of the above exceptions, a fire risk assessment will need to be carried out and approved by a Fire Safety Officer.

4- BBQs on Private Balconies / External Areas

- At your own discretion if you are the property owner, however follow guidance on 'Barbecue Safety Tips' below.

GFRS Note:

Irrespective of any points mentioned above the GFRS has the power to order that the BBQ is put out if it is deemed a fire hazard.
